UHF communication: Frequencies used for mooring is described in Equinor mooring manual. For Mongstad, UHF channel 170 is to be used, alternatively VHF channel 9. Communication with onshore base and bulk vendors are to be agreed for each operation, and in accordance with ship frequency plan.
